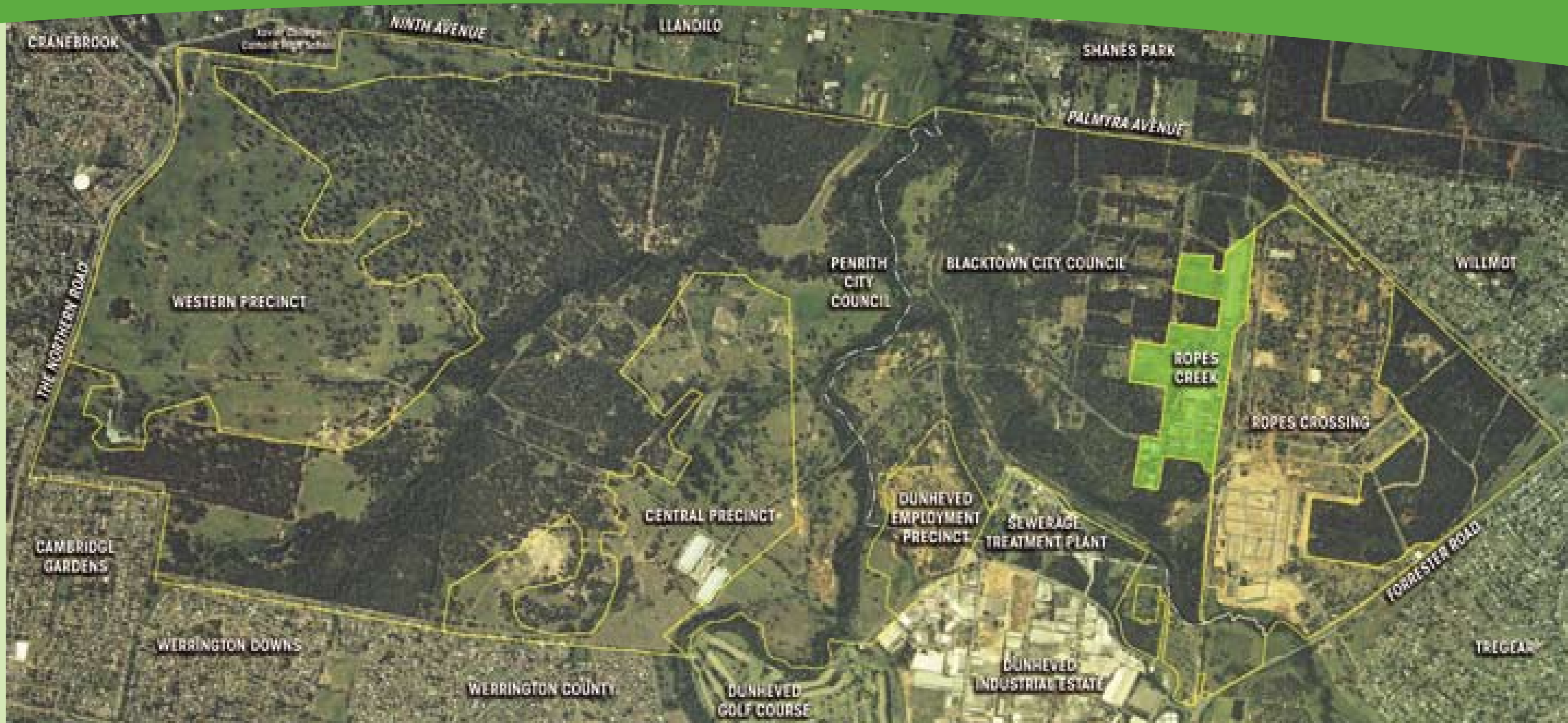


Welcome to the Community Information and Feedback Session for the planning of the Ropes Creek Precinct.
