First DA for former ADI site at St Marys on public exhibition

The first development application for the St Marys project on the former ADI site is on public exhibition at Blacktown City Council.

St Marys Project Director Arthur Ilias said the development application sought to sub-divide the Eastern Precinct into four parts, to facilitate the development process. This follows the approval of the Eastern Precinct Plan by Blacktown City Council in February.

"This Development Application is the first step towards commencing work on site. Subject to further approvals, we aim to start construction later this year," Mr Ilias said.

"It is an important part of achieving our vision for the site and the establishment of a unique and vibrant community," he said.

A Concept Plan will be exhibited alongside the Development Application.

The development application can be viewed until 16 June 2004 at Blacktown City Council, Civic Centre, Flushcombe Road, Blacktown.

Any comment on this proposal must be received in writing and lodged with Blacktown City Council by 16 June, quoting Council's file No. DA-04-1669.

The 1,545-hectare St Marys development will eventually include up to 5,000 homes contained within three distinct villages surrounded an 850 hectares Regional Park and will generate approximately 5,000 ongoing jobs for local residents.
