WorkCover NSW attends St Marys site

WorkCover NSW visited the Delfin Lend Lease's Ropes Crossing site last week following a complaint about workplace safety risks at the new residential development project at St Marys.

Inspectors from WorkCover visited the development site last week and conducted a review of Ropes Crossing's workplace health and safety processes, protocols and controls in relation to the safety concerns.

The inspectors also conducted an inspection of the site and found that on the day relevant safety procedures were being followed to ensure worker safety.

Ropes Crossing Project Director Arthur Ilias said he welcomed the recent visit by WorkCover officials to the St Marys site.

"The safety of workers on the site is our number one priority and it is pleasing to see that our onsite health and safety procedures met our legislative obligations on the day of the visit," he said.

"We will continue to work with WorkCover as we develop this community so that we can ensure that all work is done in accordance with the appropriate standards and approvals."
